- screening and counseling for sexually transmitted diseases, including HIV
- tobacco quit support

Many other services are provided with a copay.

COVER OREGON OFFERS SPECIFIC BENEFITS FOR WOMEN:

- **Access:** You can't be denied coverage, even if you already have a health condition.
- **Financial savings:** Through Cover Oregon, more individuals and families can get help paying for health insurance. See the table to the right.
- **Quality coverage:** Every plan covers the care you need. This includes doctor visits, hospital stays, mental health services, emergency room care, prescriptions, preventive care, vision coverage for kids and more. Some plans cover alternative care too. Dental plans are also available.
- **One-stop shopping:** You can compare, purchase and sign up for private insurance and public programs such as Healthy Kids and the Oregon Health Plan. Eligibility for the Oregon Health Plan is no longer determined by marital status or pregnancy, so more women will qualify.
- **Coverage for children:** If parents are insured on private plans, their dependent children can be covered on the same plan up to age 26. Children can also be on a plan without their parents and may qualify for no-cost coverage through Healthy Kids.
- **Side-by-side comparisons:** Insurance plans are compared in clear language that's easy to understand. You can search for plans that will allow you to keep seeing your current provider if you'd like.

GET FINANCIAL SAVINGS

When you enroll through Cover Oregon, you may qualify for financial savings if you earn less than the maximum yearly income shown below.

FAMILY SIZE	MAXIMUM YEARLY INCOME
1	\$45,960
2	\$62,040
3	\$78,120
4	\$94,200
5	\$110,280
6	\$126,360

Financial savings come in the form of a tax credit to help pay for premiums. If you qualify, you can choose to receive the tax credit monthly or annually.

You could also qualify for help paying out-of-pocket costs, such as copays and deductibles.

In addition, more women qualify for no-cost coverage through the Oregon Health Plan. **Take this opportunity to get the care you need for yourself.**
